

COVID-19 Screening Process and Visitation Guidelines


The safety of our patients, staff and the community remain our priority. We appreciate your cooperation in following our COVID-19 visitation policy outlined below. Any exceptions or situations not outlined in the following policy must be approved by hospital administration.

Screening

You will be asked to provide your name and contact information.

Body temperature greater than 100°	Visitation Not Allowed
Have you had close contact with a COVID+ person in the last 14 days?	Visitation Not Allowed
Have you had a COVID+ diagnosis in the last 14-days?	Visitation Not Allowed
New/unexplained cough or difficulty breathing?	Visitation Not Allowed
Experiencing two or more of the following new/unexplained symptoms: sore throat, muscle aches, headache, chills or new loss of taste or smell?	Visitation Not Allowed

Visitation Guidelines (Effective 11/23/2021)

 Designated visitation hours 8am-8pm Mon-Sun	 Visitors will be screened upon arrival.	 Minors must be able to wear a mask and be accompanied by an adult.
 Maximum of 2 visitor per patient at a time. Unlimited daily visitors.	 Visitors are restricted to patient rooms.	 Extra visitors must wait in their cars. Waiting in lobbies or public areas is not permitted.
 Visitors must adhere to 6-foot social distancing.	 All visitors must wear a hospital mask at all times.	 Visitors must wash hands before entering and exiting patient's room.
 No eating or drinking permitted in patient room.	 Common areas cannot be reserved for family events or gatherings.	 Visitors NOT PERMITTED: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - COVID+ diagnosis in the last 14 days - Patients awaiting COVID test results - COVID recovery patients still on isolation
