

# COVID-19 Screening Process and Visitation Guidelines

The safety of our patients, staff and the community remain our priority. We appreciate your cooperation in following our COVID-19 visitation policy outlined below. Any exceptions or situations not outlined in the following policy must be approved by hospital administration.

## Screening

*You will be asked to provide your name and contact information.*

Body temperature greater than 100°	<b>Visitation Not Allowed</b>
Have you had close contact with a COVID+ person in the last 14 days?	<b>Visitation Not Allowed</b>
Have you had a COVID+ diagnosis in the last 14-days?	<b>Visitation Not Allowed</b>
New/unexplained cough or difficulty breathing?	<b>Visitation Not Allowed</b>
Experiencing two or more of the following new/unexplained symptoms: sore throat, muscle aches, headache, chills or new loss of taste or smell?	<b>Visitation Not Allowed</b>

## Visitation Guidelines (Effective 8/10/2021)

 <b>Designated hours</b> 8am-8pm   Mon-Sun (varies by location)	 <b>Visitors must be at least 16 years or older.</b>	 <b>Visitors will be screened upon arrival</b>
 <b>1 visitor per patient at a time.</b>	 <b>Maximum of 2 visitors per patient, per day.</b>	 <b>Limited access to gyms, cafés, and other common areas</b> (varies by location)
 <b>Visitors may bring a mask, or one will be provided</b>	 <b>Visitors must wear a mask at all times</b>	 <b>Visitors must wash hands before entering and exiting patient's room</b>
 <b>Visitors must adhere to 6-foot social distancing</b>	 <b>No eating or drinking permitted in patient's room</b>	 <b>Visitors NOT PERMITTED:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- COVID+ diagnosis in the last 14 days</li> <li>- Patients awaiting COVID test results</li> <li>- COVID recovery patients still on isolation</li> </ul>
